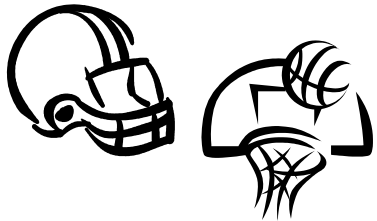


QUESTIONS

What is the First Class Pass?

The First Class Pass is a courtesy pass that is given to the senior members of our school community in recognition of their long-term investment in our young people and our schools.

What benefits are available to holders of the First Class Pass?

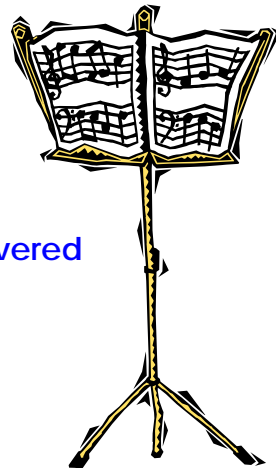


Cardholders receive a return on their investment in our schools in the form of FREE ADMISSION to all District 200 school-sponsored activities.

Who is eligible for First Class Pass privileges?

The only requirements for eligibility are:

1. Residency in District 200
2. 60 years of age or older



What specific kinds of activities are covered under the First Class Pass?

Regular season home athletic events, plays, musicals, concerts and other programs sponsored by each of our twelve schools are included. Just present your card at the door.

Are there any limitations or restrictions on the usage of the pass?

We are sorry but regulations prohibit us from honoring the First Class Pass at post-season events and special tournaments sponsored by the Illinois High School Association (IHSA), Woodstock High School or Woodstock North High School.

A few theatrical productions may require advance reservations or a nominal fee.



How can cardholders find out about upcoming events they might want to attend?

Schedules are mailed each semester to everyone who has a First Class Pass.

Cardholders may also telephone District 200 at (815) 338-5200 for a tape-recorded message of daily activities. In addition, the local and county newspapers and radio stations regularly publicize news about District 200 events. Cardholders who have access to the Internet can check the calendar page on the district's website at www.woodstockschoools.org.

How often must the First Class Pass be renewed?

Never! Your pass is valid for as long as you remain a resident of District 200.

How does one obtain a First Class Pass?

If you meet the eligibility criteria, you may stop by any of our schools or the District Office to apply for your card. If you prefer, you may telephone District 200 at (815) 338-8200 to request an application by mail. You will be given your First Class Pass as soon as we receive your completed application.

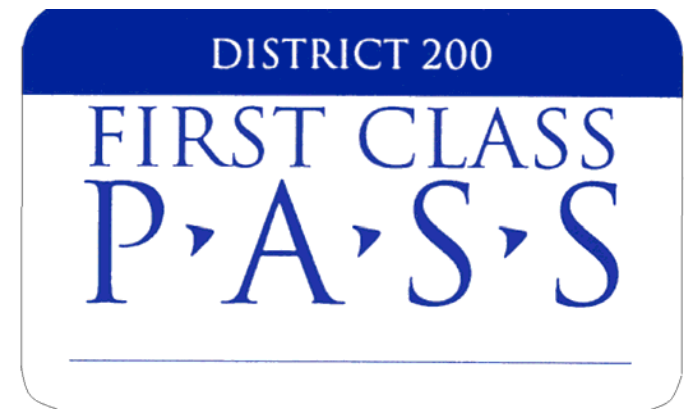
