A minimum enrollment of 20 students will be required to offer the course. Successful completion of one of these courses will result in earning 5 semester credit hours unless noted. Courses will meet **Monday through Thursday, June 6 through July 14; no classes on July 4th.** Classes run daily **8:00 am—12:00 pm.** The fee for each course is **\$385** for District 200 residents; the fee is \$415 for non-residents.

**2503 ART AND DESIGN CONCEPTS**

**0013 FRESHMAN ENGLISH**

This course is only open to students who have failed a semester of Freshman English.

**1540 GEOGRAPHY**

**1503 SSA WORLD HISTORY**

**1503 SSB** This course is only open to students who have failed a semester of World History. They must pass the appropriate final exam to receive credits.

**6503 CONSUMER EDUCATION**

This course is not open to incoming freshmen.

**1053 SSA GEOSCIENCE**

**1053 SSB** This course is only open to students who have failed a semester of Geoscience.

**1023 SSA BIOLOGY**

**1023 SSB** This course is only open to students who have failed a semester of Biology.

**9545 NOVA NET COURSES**

This instructional option involves individual course work via a computer with an instructor to successfully recover lost credits. The one fee covers the entire summer program; more than one course could be completed.

## **6113     DRIVER EDUCATION**

This course will consist of two phases: Classroom instruction and Behind the Wheel Instruction. The driver education classroom is structured to meet the requirements established by the State of Illinois and the Illinois State Board of Education. It is mandated that you receive **30 clock hours** of classroom instruction and **6 clock hours** of behind-the-wheel instruction to be eligible for a driver's license; only one absence is permitted during the summer school course.

### ***CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT INTO DRIVER EDUCATION***

As of January 1, 1994, a law was passed that impacts students' eligibility criteria for enrollment in a Driver Education Course. In addition to the WHS criteria that includes: 30 credit hours, and age 15 by June 1, 2011, students must also pass eight (8) classes in the previous two (2) semesters enrolled. Therefore, while you may complete all the registration forms, pay all fees, and reserve your space, **failure to meet the criteria will result in removal from the course; however, you will receive a refund of WHS fees.**

**All registration fees and forms for driver education must be submitted to Mrs. Mary Landa at Woodstock High School. ## The Facts

**REGISTRATION AND FEE PAYMENT:** Registration forms and fees need to be turned into your guidance counselor at Woodstock High School or Woodstock North High School. **Your counselor's signature is required to verify course selection and scheduling.**

Out-of-district students should contact **Sandra Theriault, Summer School Principal, 501 W. South Street, Woodstock, IL 60098.** Registration forms and fees should be submitted as soon as possible to allow for as many courses as possible to be offered. **Walk-in and mail-in registration will be accepted through April 29, 2011.**

Checks should be made payable to **District 200 Summer School Program.** Summer School is an optional program. Therefore, there is no consideration for a reduction or a waiver of Summer School fees. Any student wishing to register **after April 29, 2011, will be charged a \$25.00 late fee,** if the course is not already closed due to enrollment limitations. If you withdraw from a class after May 3rd, you will be charged a \$25 processing fee.

### **OUT OF DISTRICT STUDENTS:**

Students from other school districts are welcome in the District 200 Summer School Program **with the exception of Driver Education.** You will be required to pay additional fees and you will be expected to behave in the manner that is appropriate to the school setting. Please pay particular notice to the registration form where it asks for a parent's signature to allow the release of transcripts. In order to assure prompt contact with your home school regarding credit earned, this form must be completed.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Parents are responsible for the transportation of their children. They should see that their student is on time for class and picked up immediately following class. District 200 is not responsible for accidents that occur during unsupervised activities.

**ATTENDANCE:** Students are expected to be in attendance every day. **Upon the third (3) absence for five-credit and second (2) absence for two and one-half-credit classes, the student will be dropped from the course with no credit or refund.** No exceptions are made for any reason.

**ENROLLMENT:** It is necessary that a minimum class enrollment be reached before a class will be held. Each description includes that minimum. In the event that the minimum is not attained, the class will be canceled and each registered student will be notified. The student will have the option to switch to another class or a refund will be issued.
