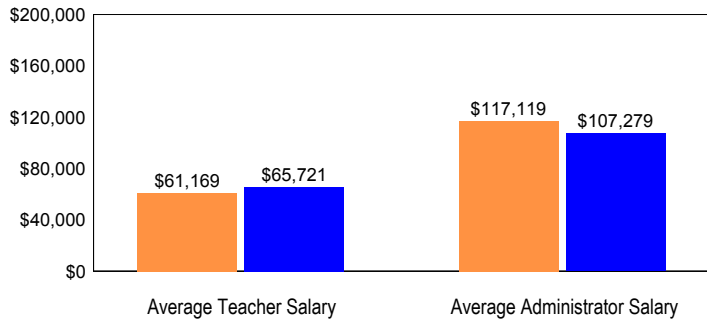

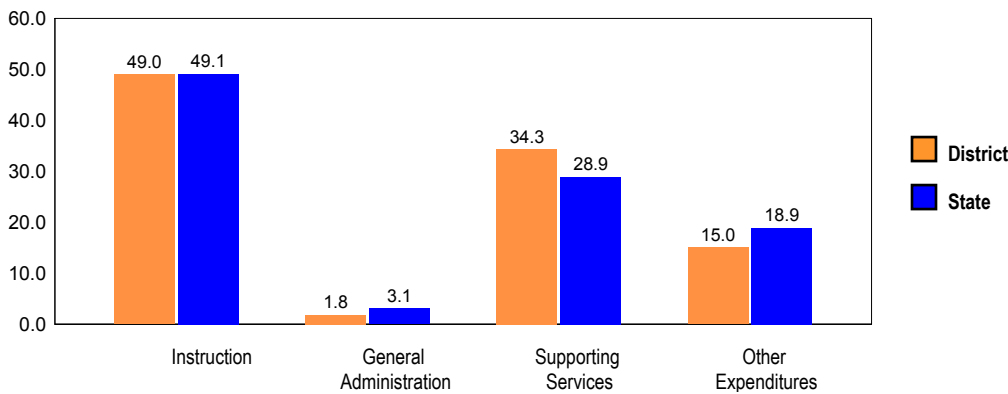
## AVERAGE TEACHER/ADMINISTRATOR SALARIES
