Our Program Includes:

- Open to students who live inside and outside of District 200 boundaries
- Teachers who hold Early Childhood and/or Early Childhood Special Education Degrees and Illinois Teaching Licenses including ESL Endorsements and/or Bilingual Endorsements
- Classroom assistants who have a minimum of 30 hours of college credit
- Class size ratio of 16 children to one teacher and associate
- Curriculum aligned with District 200 and Illinois Early Learning and Development Standards
- Easy transition from preschool to District 200 kindergarten program
- Two, three or five day a week programs
- Morning and afternoon sessions available
- Bus transportation for tuition based students is available for families for a fee
- Must be 3 years old to be enrolled

- Optional transportation is available for a fee

Application

- Applications will be accepted beginning Friday, January 19, 2024
- Required application materials include:
 - o Original or certified copy of student's birth certificate
 - o Valid state ID or driver's license
 - A non-refundable deposit of \$120.75*
 - o Completed application forms

- Prior to entry to the program a physical examination and proof of immunizations will also be required
- This is the first step of the application process. Once your application is accepted, you will then complete the registration process
