Health Services

Pre-Kindergarten Health Requirements for School Entry 2024-25

Per Board of Education Policy 7:100, all students must meet the health requirements as outlined by the Illinois Department of Public Health. All requirements must be in place before school entry. For health and safety reasons, students that are non-compliant will be excluded from school on or before October 15 of the current school year. New students who register after October 15 of the current school year shall show proof of compliance with the health examination and immunization regulations at registration.

1. Physical exams dated **on or after August 14, 2023** will be accepted and are due on the first day of school.
 - **Health Examination:** conducted within one year prior to the date of entry, is **required**.
 - **Health History Section** must be completed and **signed by the parent or legal guardian**. This is required.
 - **Lead Assessment** documentation, indicating the healthcare provider has addressed the lead poisoning questionnaire is **required**.
 - **Diabetes Risk Questionnaire** is completed if BMI for age is >85%.
2. **Immunizations:** Month/day/year and correct number of doses at the correct intervals must be verified by a health care provider. **Immunizations** are **required** as follows for pre-kindergarten entry:
 - **DPT:** 4 doses at the appropriate intervals
 - **POLIO:** 3 doses at the appropriate intervals
 - **MMR:** 1 dose on or after the first birthday
 - **HIB** vaccine: Per schedule or 1 dose at 15 months of age or older
 - **Pneumococcal (Prevnar):** Per schedule or 1 dose if has not received primary series
 - **HEPATITIS B Series:** 3 doses at appropriate intervals
 - **VARICELLA (Chicken Pox):** 1 dose on or after the first birthday or confirmation of chicken pox disease.
3. **Dental Examination** is recommended.
