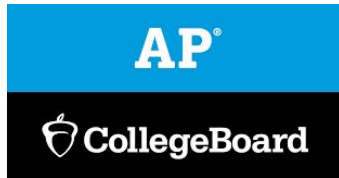
- Next year's schedule will depend on need in terms of high school/college credits and degree requirements.

Advanced Placement (AP) Credits

D200 Dual Credit Courses

- Credit earned from taking dual credit courses or college courses through/at MCC will automatically appear on the student's college transcripts.

Program Costs

- For every 3 credit MCC course the student-third will cost approximately \$150. This amount does not include a course fee or book cost.
- This amount needs to be paid prior to the first day of the course.

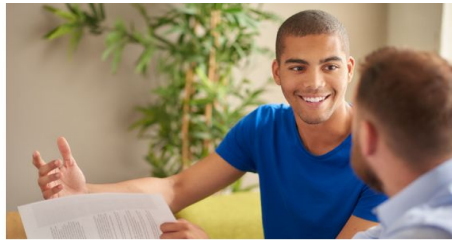
