**Return to Learn**

The county has posted their metrics for the week and we failed to meet all of the metrics in order to return to live instruction. When the Board adopted the metrics the plan called for us to move from total remote to hybrid if all of the metrics for the county were passing their set goal for the week. When the county posted their metrics for the week this afternoon one metric was not met. The metric was the weekly Count of New Cases Increase, in fact the week over week metric saw an increase of 51% for all county residents this week and 42% of school age residents this week. The goal is to stay under 10% for the week. Because of this we will stay in remote learning next week. We will update our status next Friday when the metrics are posted to see if we can start on October 26.

I know how hard you have all worked the last few weeks to have our live instruction hybrid ready to go and I wish today had brought better news. I do appreciate all of the work you had done to be ready for the hybrid plan. We will be ready to implement the plan when it's time. I know we all want students back in our school buildings as much as I do. In District 200 we will bring them back when our local health professionals have told us it is safe to do so. Take time to relax this weekend and return to our remote learning plan on Monday. Please let me know if you have any questions. I hope you all know how much I appreciate all that you have done for our students.
