Applications available for D200 school board

The Woodstock Community Unit School District 200 Board of Education is accepting applications to fill a vacancy on the school board left by the resignation of Board Member David Shinherr.

Shinherr, who is relocating for a job in another state, has served on the Board for six years, most recently as vice president. "David Shinherr has been a champion for our schools, for our students and for our community. We sincerely appreciate his leadership and service to District 200," Superintendent Mike Moan said.

The successful replacement candidate will be appointed at the Nov. 13 board meeting and will serve until the April 2, 2019 election. In order to be eligible for consideration, candidates must be citizens of the United States, at least 18 years old, reside in the State of Illinois and the school district for at least one year, and registered to vote.

According to Board policy, the applicant must not be a resident of Dorr or Greenwood Townships. Additional requirements for board candidacy are contained in Board Policy 2:40 which is on the district website at www.woodstockschoools.org.

The deadline for submitting applications for the Board of Education is Nov. 9. Candidates will be interviewed the evening of Nov. 13.

Interested applicants should submit their name, address, resume and a statement no longer than two typewritten pages indicating the reasons why they are interested in serving on the Board of Education.
